<p>Early Morning Flight</p> <p>6:30am Drop Off @ Airport for Check-In Flight Departs / Arrives</p> <p>9:30-11:30am Pu'uhonua O Honaunau National Park (City of Refuge) Currently a National Park, it was a safe refuge for lawbreakers in ancient Hawaii. Lawbreakers that made it there & performed certain rituals were forgiven & could return home without penalty. Tour the park & participate in some Hawaiian Games. Picnic Lunch in Park [45minute drive-Kona]</p> <p>12:30-2:00pm Hulihe'e Palace, Pohaku Likanaka & Palace Gift Shop Palace built in 1838 & became the house of choice for vacationing Hawaiian royalty until 1914. Also see a execution pohaku of old.</p> <p>Mokuaikaua Church First Christian Church built in the islands in 1820. Interesting architecture made of lava rock, crushed coral & koa hardwood, a magnificent remnant of that era. There are exhibits relating to early Hawaii & work of missionaries, along with a model of Thaddeus, the ship that brought the first missionaries to the islands.</p> <p>2:30-3:30pm Pu'ukohola Heiau National Historic Site Visit a magnificent heiau built by Kamehameha the Great on a hill in Kawaihae. As instructed by kahunas, this heiau was built to ensure that he would be successful in conquering and unifying all the islands.
